Tax Collection Report:

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer Terry McNatt presented the financial report, noting that 37% of the budget remains with only November and December left in the 2025 fiscal year. Justice Pasmore inquired whether the Courthouse Annex was still receiving construction invoices. Judge Day responded that all retainage has been paid out except for \$5,000.
